ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR THE ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 2023 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS A GENERAL REVENUE SALES TAX TO BE USED FOR STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. An election for the City of Lathrop, Missouri shall be held on April 4, 2023 in conjunction with the general municipal election for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City a General Revenue Sales Tax Question, with such funds designated for street improvements, pursuant to R.S.Mo. 94.510.

Section 2. The Election will be held at the following place, as designated by the Clerk of Clinton County: Goppert Community Center, 406 Elm Street, Lathrop, MO 64465.

Said election will be held and the polling places for same will be open between the hours of 6:00 o'clock in the morning and 7:00 o'clock in the evening.

Section 3. The ballot of submission shall contain substantially the following language:

Ballot Question

Shall the city of Lathrop, Missouri, impose a city sales tax of 1%, with such funds to be used for the improvement of streets?

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Clerk of Clinton County, Missouri, of the passage of this Ordinance no later than 4:30 PM on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, and to include in said notification all of the terms and provisions required by Chapter 115, RSMo, as amended.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Board of Alderman of the City of Lathrop, Missouri.
Read twice and passed by a majority vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop, Missouri, this 17th day of January, 2023.
