City of Lathrop Extends City Facilities Closure

While Maintaining City Services

Due to COVID-19 concerns and in an effort to continue our ability to provide City Services, mitigate the risk of exposure to the public and to protect our employees, the City of Lathrop, MO has decided to extend the closure of the following City Facilities to the public until we receive a clearance form the CDC or our local County Health Department:

- Lathrop City Hall
- Lathrop Police Department
- Brazelton Community Center
- Goppert Community Center
- Lathrop City Barns

During this time the City encourages residents and customers to take advantage of the online City services, including payment of City water bills. Pay your water bill online at <https://www.cityof.lathropmo.org> using the Pay Water Bill drop down. Payments may also be left in the drop box at City Hall, or mailed to City of Lathrop, 707 Oak Street, PO Box 225, Lathrop, MO 64465.

Residents should stay informed and ensure that they are receiving accurate information from reliable sources. The Center for Disease Control (CDC) provides up-to-date information on their website and social media platforms. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHHS) has activated a 24/7 phone hotline (877-435-8411) for the public or providers to receive information or guidance related to COVID-19.
