ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL THREE PERCENT SALES TAX ON THE RETAIL SALE OF ADULT-USE, NON-MEDICINAL MARIJUANA IN THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 1376 the Board of Aldermen ordered an election to be held in the City on April 2, 2024, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City the following question:

Shall the city of Lathrop, Missouri, impose a city sales tax of three percent (3%) on all retail sales of adult use non-medicinal marijuana sold in the City of Lathrop, Missouri?

WHEREAS, the votes cast at said election were duly canvassed as provided by law, and it was found and declared that a majority of the qualified voters of the City voting at said election on said question voted in favor of the imposition of said sales tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby authorizes the City to impose a general revenue sales tax of 3% pursuant to Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall forward to the Missouri Department of Revenue a certified copy of this Ordinance and of Ordinance 1376, and certifications of the election results on the question for the April 2, 2024 election.

Read twice and passed by a majority vote of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop, Missouri, this 21st day of May, 2024.
