NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:	
SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby authorizes the City to impose an additional general revenue sales tax of 1% on metered water services; electricity and electrical current; natural, artificial and propane gas; wood; coal; and home heating oil, pursuant to R.S.Mo. 94.510 and R.S.Mo. 144.032, with such funds to be designated for street improvements.	
SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall forward to the Missouri Department of Revenue a certified copy of this Ordinance, Ordinance 1364, and Ordinance 1368, and certifications of the election results on the question for the April 4, 2023 election.
