ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI 2024 TAX LEVY AS ESTABLISHED AT THE TAX LEVY PUBLIC HEARING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, The City of Lathrop is required to establish a tax levy by September 1st of each calendar year; and,

Whereas, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop, Missouri held a public hearing on August 20, 2024 to establish the 2024 tax levy; and,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop, Missouri, as follows:

1. The tax levy shown is the levy that was agreed upon by the Board of Aldermen during the Public Hearing on August 20, 2024. The Board of Aldermen approve the following figures for the 2024 tax levy:

Category	Amount
General Fund	\$0.5712
Park Fund	\$0.1503
Debt Service Fund	\$0.4219
Total	\$1.1434

2. The ordinance approving the 2024 tax levy shall be in full force and effect as of September 1, 2024 upon approval by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop.

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF LATHROP, MISSOURI

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 110.020 of the City Code of Lathrop, Missouri, the compensation of the Mayor shall be \$1800.00 per year, paid in quarterly installments, effective after the April 2026 municipal election.

Section 2. Pursuant to section 110.230 of the Municipal Code of Lathrop, Missouri, the compensation of the Members of the Board of Aldermen shall be \$1200.00 per year, paid in quarterly installments, effective after the April 2026 municipal election.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lathrop.
