**1. Call to Order**

Alderman Porter moved to place the ordinance on its first reading. Alderman Donnie Quinn seconded the motion that passed by the following roll call vote.

Alderman Porter Hensen moved to place the ordinance on its final passage. Alderman Gerald Snodgrass seconded the motion that passed by the following roll call vote. Aye: Aldermen Donnie Quinn, Coetta Whiteley, Porter Hensen and Gerald Snodgrass. Nay: none.

**12. Ordinance No. 1363 – Street Bonds**

Mayor Morrison introduced Ordinance No. 1363 calling for the election for the purpose of submitting to the voters a General Obligation Bond question for a Street Improvement Project.

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Alderman Porter Hensen moved to place the ordinance on its first passage. Alderman Coetta Whiteley seconded the motion. Results of the roll call vote. Aye: Alderman Porter Hensen and Coetta Whiteley. Nay: Aldermen Donnie Quinn, Gerald Snodgrass and Mayor Jennifer Morrison. Motion failed.

Still have fence and other punch list items to complete including finishing landscaping.


