City of Lathrop to Open City Hall Lobby

While COVID-19 remains a concern, the City has decided to open City Hall on May 4, 2020 while still meeting the guidelines set by the Clinton County Health Department. The order, 20-02, was issued April 30, 2020. The order can be viewed on our website.

We still plan to keep the Community Rooms closed to the public for now.

- Goppert Community Center – **Remains closed**

Payments may also be left in the drop box at City Hall, or mailed to City of Lathrop, 707 Oak Street, PO Box 225, Lathrop, MO 64465. Lobby payments will be accepted beginning May 4, 2020.
